The children will be learning to sing a rhyme a day. You will receive a song booklet to help sing the songs at home.

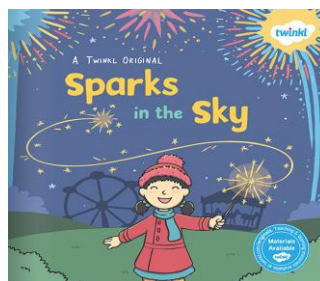
Anti Bullying Week
