

We have had a very busy week this week.

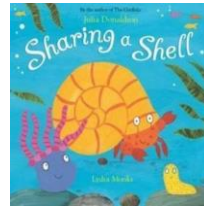
Part of Anti Bullying week we talked about what makes a good friend and drew some super pictures of our friends and made friendship bands.
