

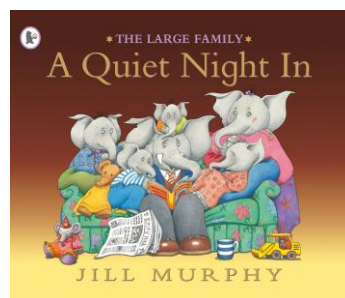
This week we have read stories about Mr and Mrs Large and their family. We were really good at talking about events in the stories and what happened in the beginning, middle and end of the story.
