watching the movements.

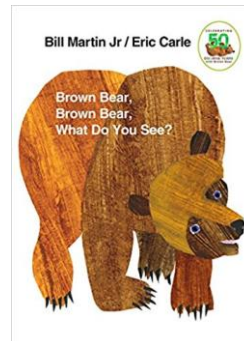
Next week...
