We Love Color!

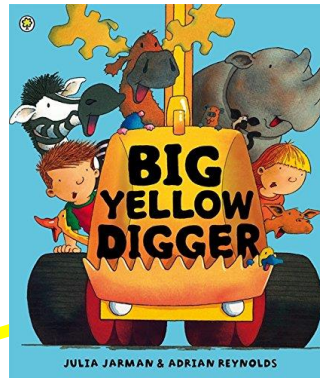
Tune: Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes
