We hope you all enjoyed your Easter break and are looking forward to the new term. The topics for this term are as follows:

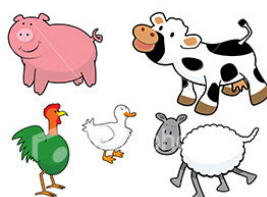
