

Recycle Centre

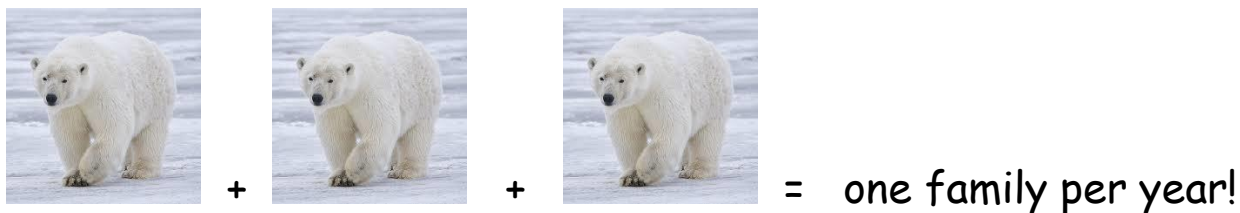


Year one enjoyed a visit to their local recycle centre.

Sorting the rubbish!



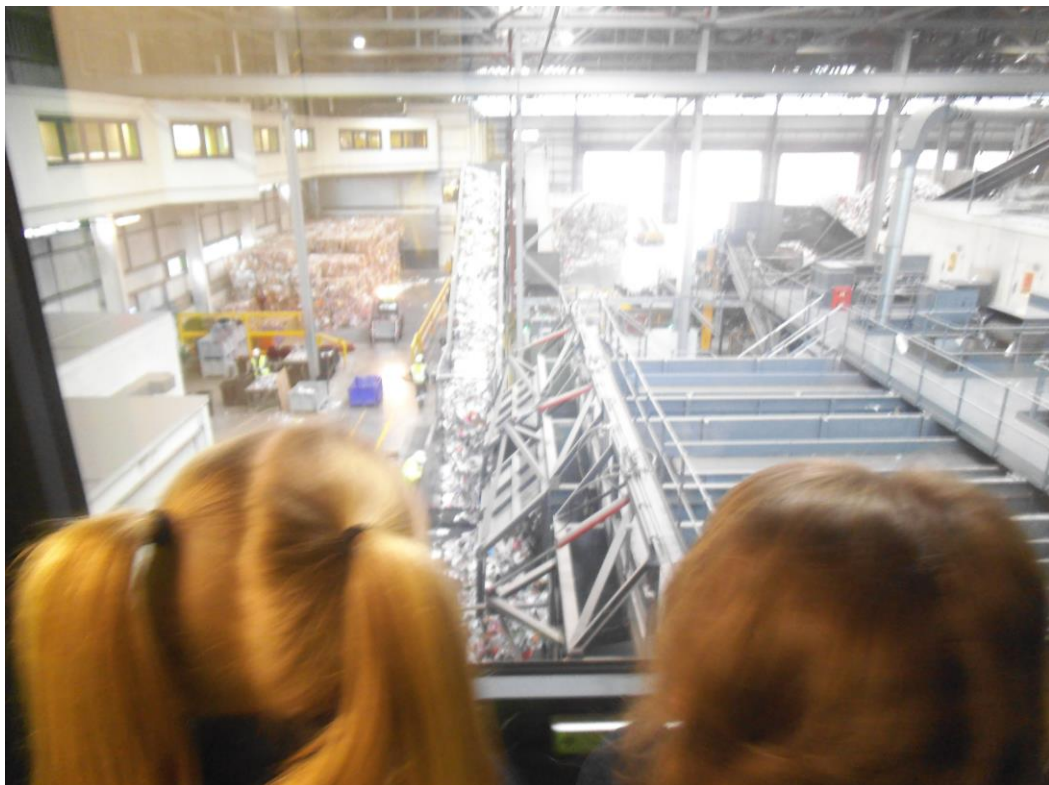
Do you know what goes in the blue bin?
