
Little Jackie, Jack Frost

The Storm Whale in Winter

Children have enjoyed learning about the story 'The Storm Whale in Winter' this week. They predicted and drew pictures about what might happen next. Children talked about the characters in the book and ordered the things that happened at the beginning, middle and end of the story.

We matched numbered mittens to mittens with objects on. Children practised their number recognition by fishing for numbered fish in the ice.
