He has a lot of rhythm and we call him heart

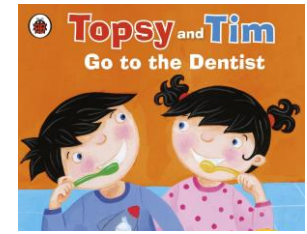
He lives in a cage inside our chest
