



What is it?

The Children's University promotes, recognises and accredits out-of-school hours *Learning Activities* at Lister Infant School.

Why?

Lister Infant School and the Children's University share the same ambition which is to raise aspiration, boost achievement and foster a ***love of learning and learning for life.***



How?

Participation is voluntary and is open to every child! The learning activities are something other than school. There are a range of sessions available from sport to creative and indoor and outdoor learning!



Every child who participates in an out of hour activity is accredited with points. The points are accumulated and rewards are given at the end of each academic year.

The points start with a Bronze Award which totals 30 hours and go up to Gold Fellowship Awards for 1000 hours!

Every unique child's journey is recorded. The points are rolled over into each new academic year ***and*** into the junior school.

When?

At the end of each academic year, parents and children are invited to a reward ceremony to acknowledge the points accredited by each child. The children are cap and gowned and greeted by a VIP.

Lister Infant school have been offering a range of out of school activities for a long time and have evidenced good impact of uptake of club places.

2016 – 2017 is the third year in which the school has joined with the Children's University. 82% of children chose to take part in a club this term!
