

Numbers are fun! Let's play some games.....

What's my number?

Make a bag with numbers 1- 10 inside. Each person takes out a number in turn. Without showing anyone they must describe the number - My number is the number after 5; before 3, one more than/less than etc.

Shapes all around!

What shapes can you see around the house? What is the name of the shapes (2D - circle, square, triangle - 3D Sphere, Cube, prism,) Draw or take a photo of the objects.

Smelly socks!

From a pile of single socks - can you match the socks and make a pair. Match by pattern/ size. Hang them on the washing line in pairs. How many socks? How many pairs?



Sing a number song - La, La, La!

Five little ducks, 10 in the bed, five currant buns - songs can be googled or ask School for a copy of the words. Use maths language such as - How many, how many are there left? Take one away,

A Birthday Cake for Teddy!

Together you can

Find a recipe - what ingredients do we need? How much?

Make a shopping list

Find and pay for the ingredients at the shops

Follow the recipe - count out how much is needed

Put the mixture into a cake tin/into the oven (adult assistance) - temperature, hot.

Time how long it will take to cook (minutes, how long)

Decorate - cut and enjoy (fractions - quarter, half)

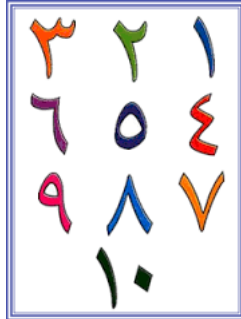


Maths Language:-

How much? One more/less, what shape is the cake? Which coins do we need to pay for the shopping? Watching the clock to time the cake. Cutting the cake into pieces - half, quarter, etc.

Maths Language:-

How many invitations/cups/plates? One more/less. What shape is the hat? What shape decorations shall we put on the hat? Long, longer, longest, short, shorter, shortest.
