"A stranger is somebody you don't know at all or someone you don't know very well."

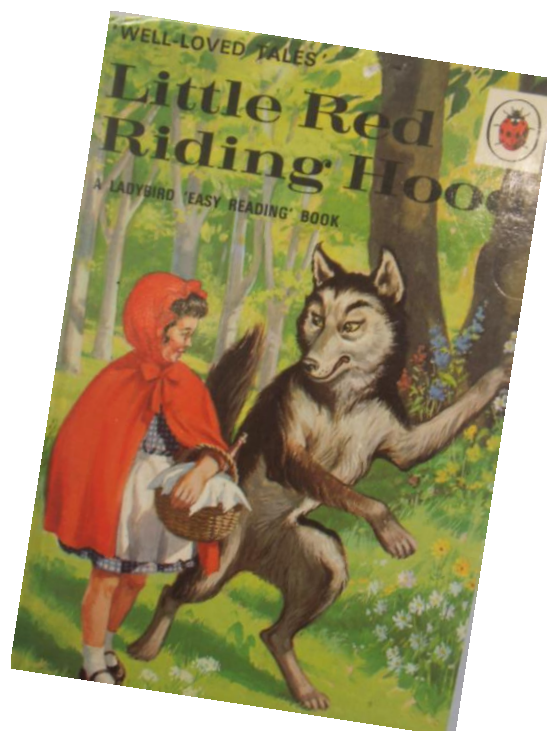
"A stranger can be a man, woman or teenager. Any size, age or colour. They don't all wear black shoes and huddies!"

try to be your friend.**



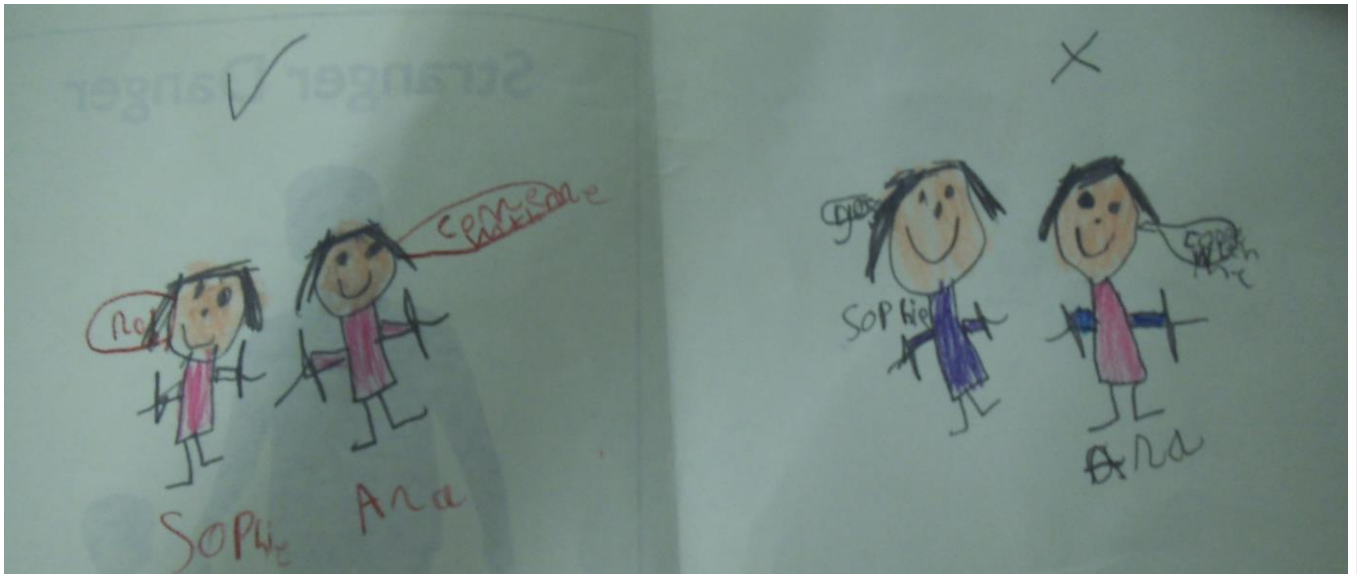
The children read a traditional tale about a little girl and a stranger and they discussed what she should and shouldn't have done.
