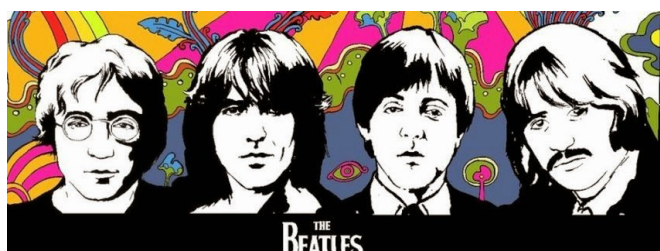
Phonics Demonstration Lesson
