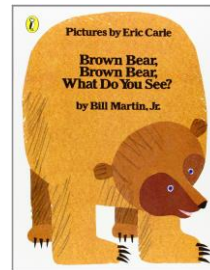


The colour for this week's learning was orange. The children loved listening to the story of the week and building a cave for the bear in our construction challenge.
