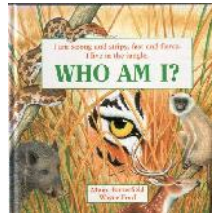

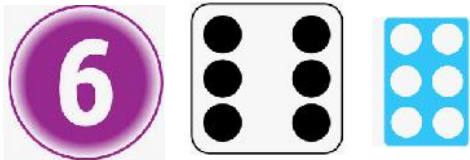
Story of the week
