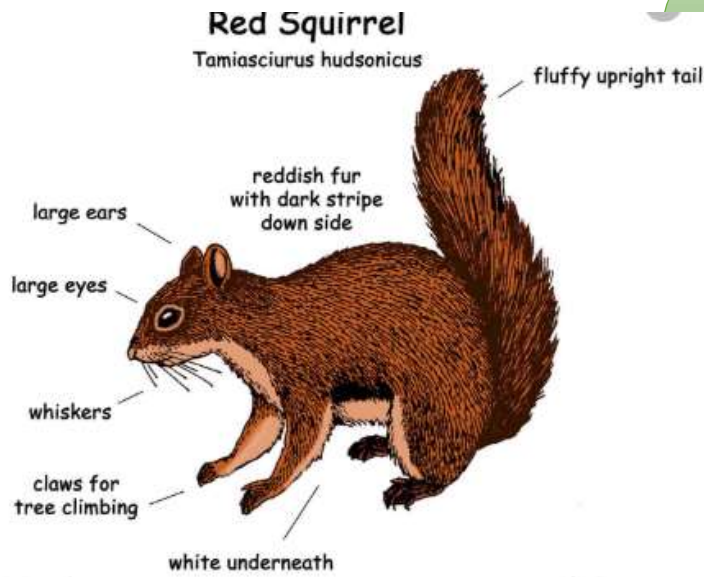


Animal Factfile

A red squirrel's natural habitat is a woodland environment. The red squirrel's diet consists of nuts, fruits and seeds from cones in autumn and in winter.

A red squirrel uses the trees in the woodland to shelter from predators.

In the woodland there is lots of space to play and run around. There are other squirrels in the natural habitat so there is an opportunity to reproduce.

Did you know a red squirrel might be eaten by a fox , a bear or a snake?
