September 2020

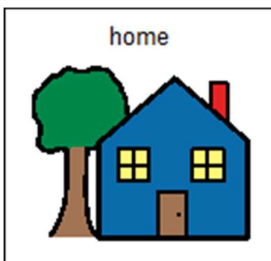
School has been closed for a long time.

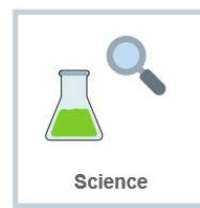
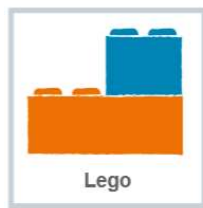

When I move around school, I will follow the one-way system and use the red/white tape markings to make sure I don't get too close to the person in front.

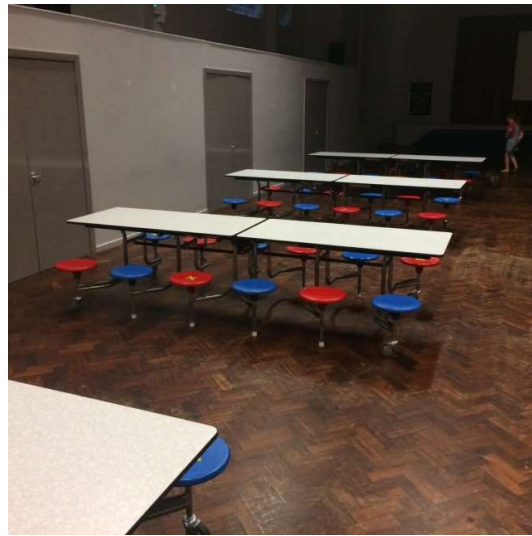


Mrs Gordon has hidden some pictures on the tape so I will see if I can find them!

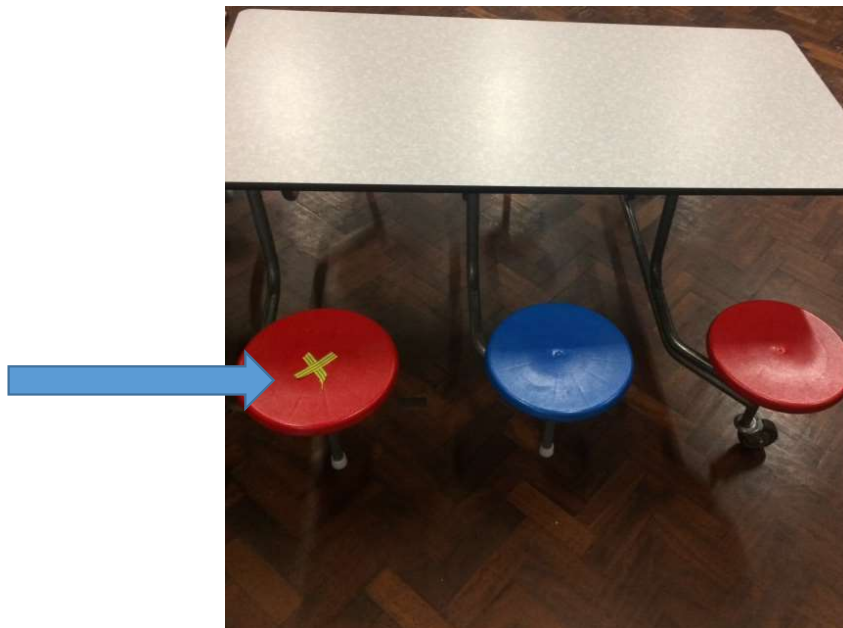




At Lunchtime, I will have lunch in the Junior Hall.



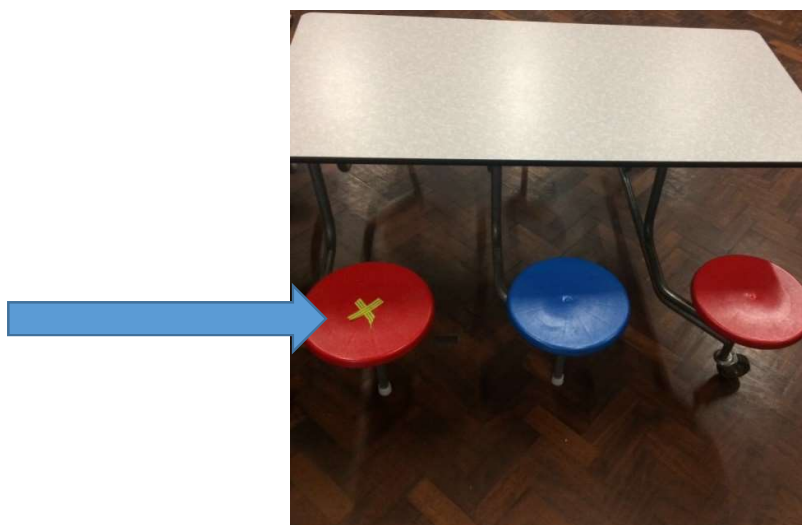
If I have a packed lunch, I will sit on a seat with a cross on it.
