REMINDER: There will be no crossing patrol by St Cecilia Junior School over the next few weeks so please use the pedestrian crossing. Stay safe.

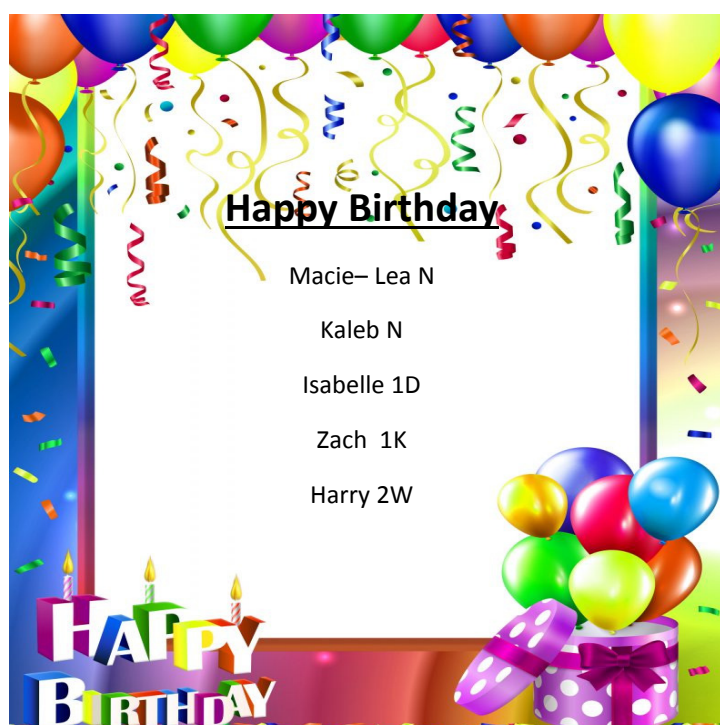
