Please return your Home Reader book on a Thursday. Your child will choose a new Home Reader on a Friday. Your child must have a bag for the book in order to take the book home.



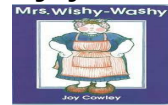

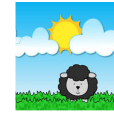
