Summer Playscheme

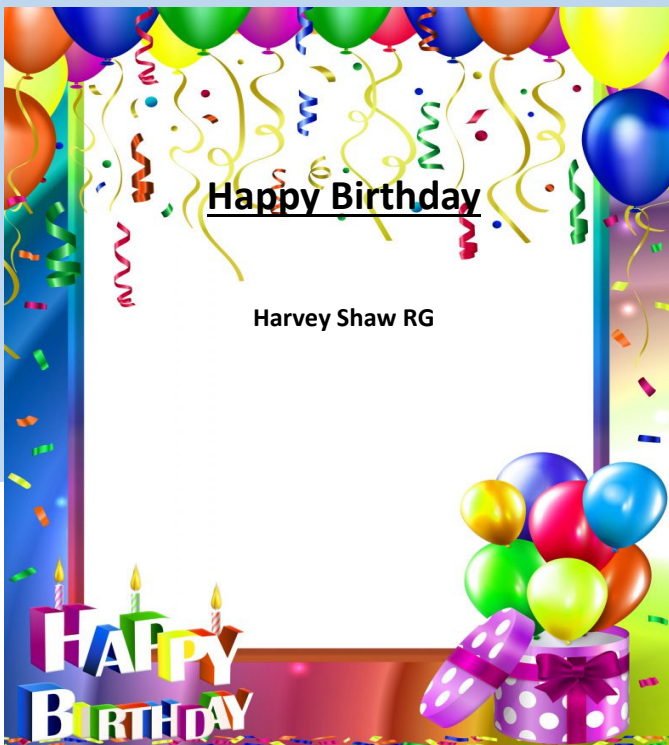
