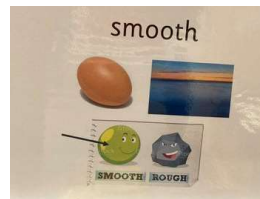
In our maths we have been exploring the number 2. We have been finding the number 2 in our environment and representing it in different ways.
