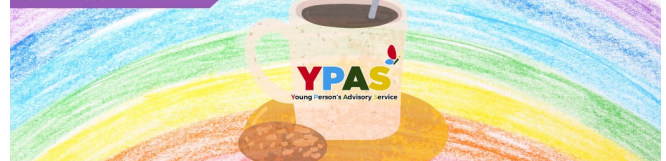


## Reception Toast Mornings

### Covid Guidelines
