## Deaf Awareness Week

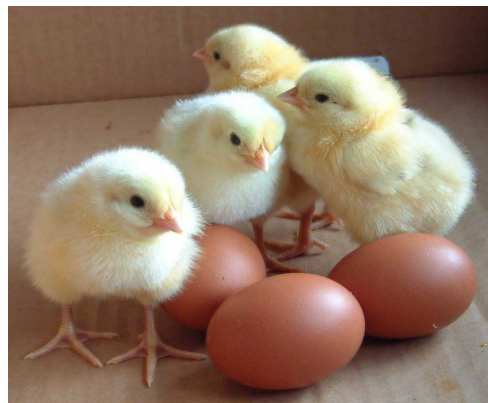

## KDOS Deaf Awareness Week

2nd - 8th May 2022

### Tips to be more deaf aware...



Make sure you have the person's attention, speak clearly and do not cover your mouth.



Check that the person understands what you are saying. If they don't try explaining in a different way.



Maintain eye contact throughout your conversation.



Try to communicate in a quiet environment and do not shout, this could be uncomfortable for hearing aid users.

There are at least 50,000 children who are deaf in the UK

Four babies are born deaf in the UK every day

British Sign Language is used by over 87,000 Deaf people in the UK

Nine in every ten deaf children are born to hearing parents

Deafness is the third most common disability in the world

But only 1 in 10 hearing parents will learn sign language to communicate fully with their child!
