This Week...

We have enjoyed another busy week in Reception. As part of our topic 'Up, Up and Away' we read the story 'Raft ride'. We then wrote our own raft ride stories. "First the giraffe got on the raft...". The children had so much fun creating their own versions of the story.

In our phonics we have been learning to read words with five graphemes. We have read words such as stamp, crisp, string and scrunch. We also learnt the tricky words, were, here, little and says.

In maths we have been learning all about the composition of number 7 for example, 3 and 4 makes 7 or 5 and 2 makes 7. The children have enjoyed finding different ways to make 7. Challenge at home – how many different ways can you make 7 at home? For example, 2 cars and 5 dolls.
