Timelines	Year One	Year Two
Term 1	I can use real, concrete artefacts to learn about the past. Focus on single sources. E.g. medals, people	I can use secondary sources to learn about the past. Using abstract sources E.g. photographs, newspaper articles, diaries, books
Term 2	I can use real artefacts to learn about the past and begin to use secondary sources.  E.g. toys, people, photographs, books	I can use the internet to learn about the past.
