

This Week....

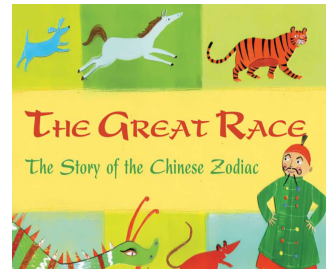
