This terms activities, language and experiences are based on 'Down on the Farm'.

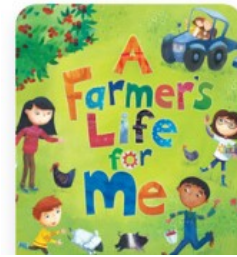
We have enjoyed farm role play, printing our favourite animals and learning to play lotto at our games table.

We hope you have fun!



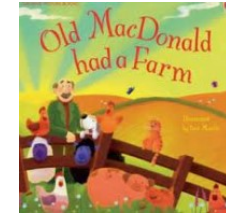
Rhyme of the Week
