We have enjoyed another busy week in Reception. Continuing our focus on the story of Hansel and Gretel, the children have written descriptions of the witch.




We continued learning how to chunk up longer words such as wooden, farmyard, marching and garden. The children have also been practicing writing sentences like "I can zoom down the hill."
