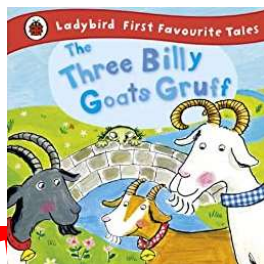
In maths we have been learning all about the number 8. We have been making 8 with different objects, drawing 8 and ordering up to 8.
