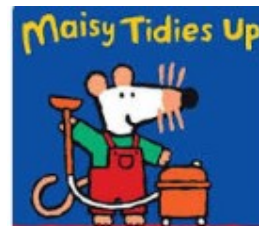


This week we have been learning to name and find our body parts, we sang our rhyme and played games to help us too. We learnt to play pairs at the games table, finding the same body parts on cards.
