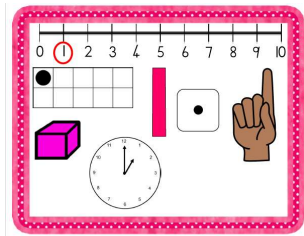


## This Week.....

The children have really enjoyed talking about how we have grown and changed. In our topic session we made timelines to show how we grow and change.

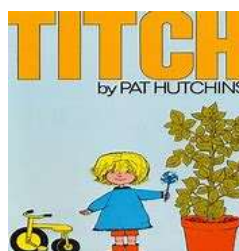
