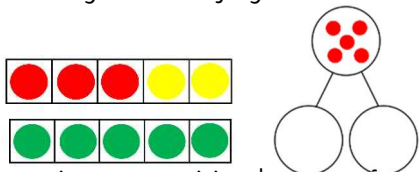


This Week.....

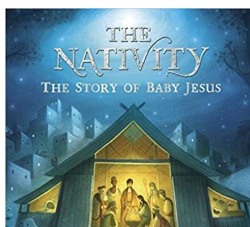
