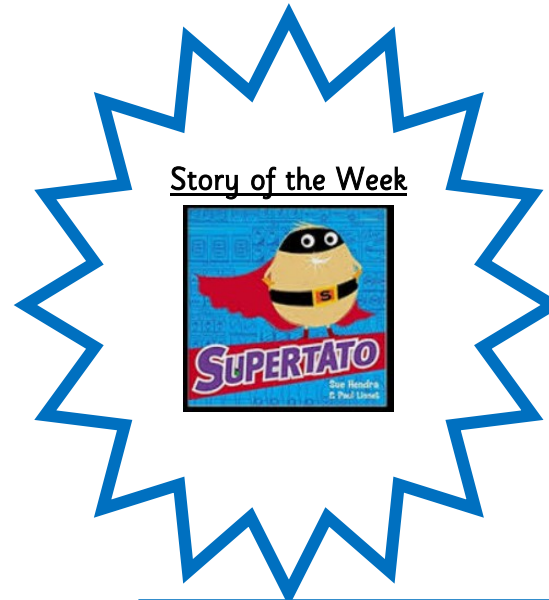


There has been great excitement in Nursery this week and it's down to our story of the week!
