In maths, we have been ordering numbers 1 to 5. We had so much fun filling in the missing numbers and using the numicon to order 1-5.

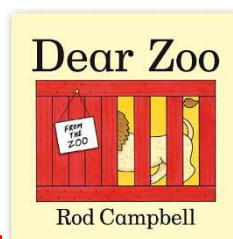
