In maths, we have been learning about one less up to 5. The children have been doing this practically by taking one item away. Can they show you how to do this at home?

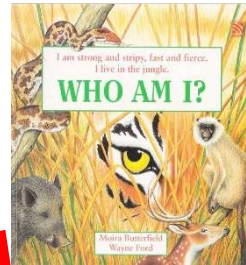
