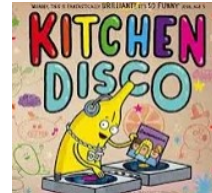
This week the children have also celebrated Safer Internet Day. The children talked about how they use the internet and learnt about how to keep safe.
