

This term the children are learning about clothes in our topic called "What Shall I Wear?" This week the children have enjoyed listening to our story of the week called Aliens Love Underpants.



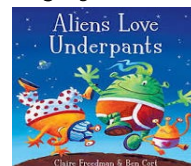
The children have also been learning about making patterns and they created their own repeating patterns using paint to print their own design on a pair of underpants for our Aliens Love Underpants display.



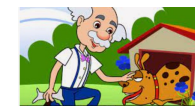
This week the children also enjoyed learning about Pancake Day and they made their very own tasty pancakes too!
