
This Week.....

We have continued learning our letters and sounds. In phonics, we are learning to read words with two or more digraphs. We have read words such as 'torch, cheep and chain'. We have also been practising reading all of our tricky words.

In maths, we have been learning about number 7. We have been counting out 7 objects and recognising 7 in lots of different ways.
