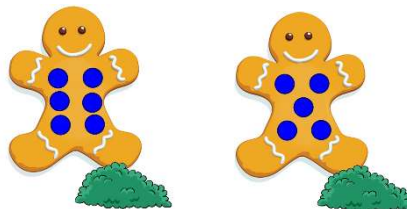


## This Week...
