In circle time, we shared our Easter holiday news and we loved hearing about the children's adventures.

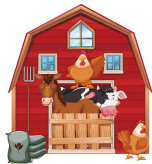


This term's activities, language and experiences are based on 'Down on the Farm'.

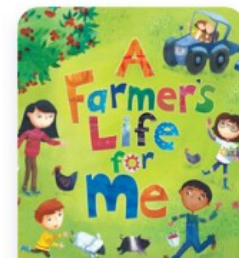
We have enjoyed exploring the farm role play. Jobs have included taking on the role of a farmer, feeding the lambs and collecting and sorting fruit.
