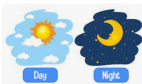


This week Nursery have been learning about opposites. They explored measuring the length of flowers to find out about the opposites of tall and short.

Next Week

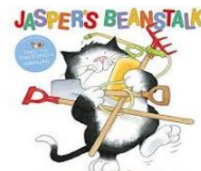
