We have finished Yoga for this term. After half term our PE day will be Monday.

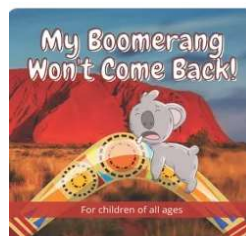

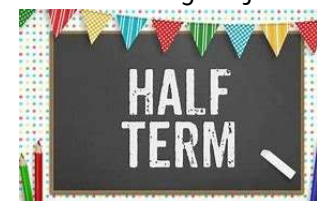


Half Term Holiday
