We have had so much fun settling into our new reception classes this week!

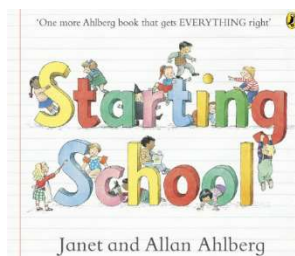
