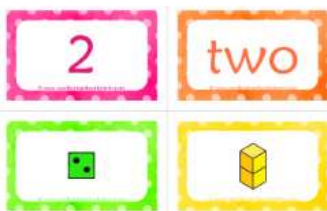


## This Week.....
