In PE we have been practicing lots of different skills. We enjoyed playing what's the time Mr Wolf and Grandma's Footsteps.

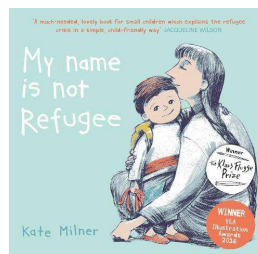
Following on from last week's session in Forest School the children have enjoyed planting beetroot and carrots and can't wait to watch them grow!
