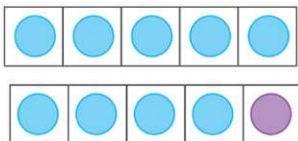


This Week....

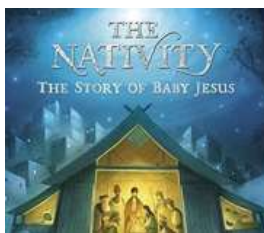
