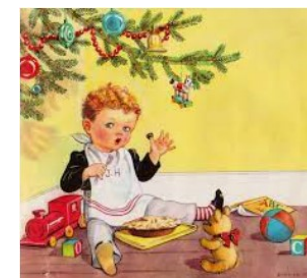


This week the children have been learning about heavy and light. Ask your child to find two toys and say which is heavy and which is light.
