Monday 3rd June at 8:45am.

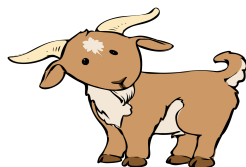
Kitchen

Thank you to all our families who came to our International Family Day on Tuesday. It was lovely to see everyone interacting and having fun with each other - you all helped to make it a great success!

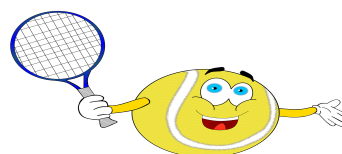
Nursery Chicks
