In maths we have been looking at the composition of 8. The children have been using the part, part whole model to show different ways to make 8.

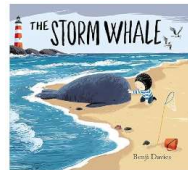
We have been learning all about what plants need to grow. We have enjoyed planting some seeds and are looking forward to watching these grow over the next few weeks.
