We have continued learning our letters and sounds and we have learnt another 4 phonemes this week. We have learnt i, n, m and d. We have been reading words like dip, mat, tin.


In maths, we have been learning about matching and sorting into sets. The children have been busy sorting object by colour, size, feature and matching sets that are the same.


